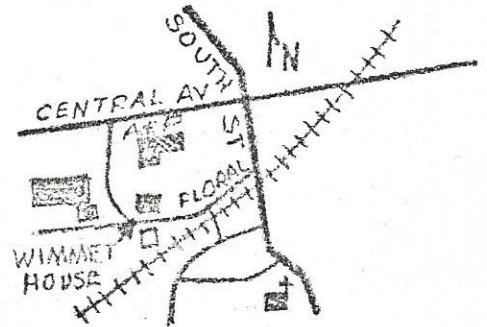

1. Items for exchange can be tendered in one of two ways...
 - A. Donate the item to the club
 - B. Maintain ownership until sold
 - a) The club will deduct 10%
 - b) Owner may stipulate minimum sale price
2. Items for sale will be accepted from club members only
Any person may submit donated items
3. Sellers must remove unsold items from the premises
4. The master of ceremonies may--
 - A. Bid for his own account
 - B. Combine donated lots
 - C. Ask for reduced minimum sale price
5. Successful bidders must consummate their purchases immediately
