

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT FIELD DAY

Place ... is the former Nike Radar Base off Glenside Avenue, nearby to Governor Ivingston Regional High School, Entrance off Glenside Avenue ONLY.



The Dates ... are Saturday, June 25, through Sunday, June 26. Please report by 9 a.m. in order that antennas can be erected and stations set up and checkel out in time to go on the air at 5 p.m. Operations then will be continuous until 5 p.m., Sunday.

Bring With You ... your license, your lunch for Saturday noon and your eating utensils.

If possible bring with you any gallon or larger containers filled with water. There is no water on the base so we will have to bring in what we need.

Club Will Provide ... dinner en Saturday and breakfast and lunch on Sunday, with the cost being pro-rated among members. Quite likely there will be a midnight snack and there will be continuous coffee.
