

Field Day this year is June 28 & 29, and already much progress has been made in organizing the event. As noted above, our new Field Day call will be K2JV, courtesy of our 1980 culinary artist (i.e., food chairman) Barry Cohen. Wallace Murray, WB2JHI, expects to have his big diesel generator on hand to supply the wattage for the various stations, fans, air conditioners and color TV sets which are expected this year.

Current plans are to have a phone and a CW station operating 80 - 10 meters. A natural (muscle) powered station is also in the planning stage. For the benefit of the 30% of our Club's licensed membership who hold either the Novice or Technician class license, we hope to see a Novice/Tech CW station on 80, 40, 15 and 10.

If you are interested in participating on Field Day for 1 hour or for 31 hours, if you are interested in helping with the setting up, the operating, the logging (no license required), the generators, the food, the packing up, or all of the above, then we ask you to come to the meeting on June 9 to help Andy make this one of our most enjoyable Field Days, ever!!!

Meetings will continue throughout the summer on a twice-a-month basis. Topics of radio interest will be discussed and any problems or discoveries of any member are welcome. However, the Mountain Spark Gap bulletin will not be issued again until the fall; just prior to the first September meeting.
